

## **2016 Take Pride in Smith Mountain Lake Final Report**

The 2016 Take Pride in Smith Mountain Lake clean up event ran from May 7<sup>th</sup> through September 5<sup>th</sup>. During that time, 17 events were registered with 172 participants included in the registrations.

Event coordinators came to the TLAC office to pick up supplies. Of the 17 events registered, a representative from 16 of the events came to the office for distribution of supplies. A total of 496 trash bags and 168 pairs of gloves were distributed. Many of the groups indicated that they planned to have additional clean up events after the official timeline for the 2016 Take Pride event ended.

Of the 17 events, 13 official trash collection reports were received by TLAC staff. Based on an average of 50 lbs. of trash per bag, plus breakdowns from residents of additional items that were not bagged, approximately 12.86 tons of debris were collected, with approximately 45.25 miles of shoreline/water reported being covered during the event.

The attached trash collection report represents an estimate of the total numbers of items collected and bags filled during the 17 events. This report is based on figures provided on each individual group's trash collection report and may not represent the actual total of debris collected during the events.
